As an alternative, you may also apply online at www.riverton.org/apply-now . The application needs to be filled out completely, accurately, and legibly. We will not process an incomplete application. Any misstatements or omissions made on your application, whether discovered before or after you move into the building, is grounds for denial of an application or termination of an existing tenancy. Information must also be verifiable. If information given to us on the application cannot be checked out and verified, this is a basis for rejection. | | |
| RENTAL HOUSING HISTORY. Two Years of favorable, verifiable rental housing history (non-relative). See Exceptions below* QUALIFYING CREDIT. Credit references will be checked. An adverse credit reference, a high amount of household debt, an open balance due to a prior housing provider, open collections, bankruptcy and judgments may be grounds for rejection of an application. EVICTION FILINGS. Unlawful detainer or eviction case history will be checked. Eviction actions within the past three (3) years for non-payment of rent, or eviction actions for any period of time for breach of lease, failure to vacate, or other reasons besides non-payment, may be a basis for rejection of your application.
